


want to jet off to a destination thousands of miles away, you're sure to find the perfect sunny escape on this list.




Crete, Greece BEST PLACES TO STAY → Crete is the southernmost island in Greece, enjoying the country's warmest temperatures, with April often idyllic. If you visit outside of Easter week, you can take advantage of lower rates and thinner crowds, wonderful for spending the day on Crete's beautiful beaches like Balos, with its stretches of pink-hued sands accessed via a hike down the rugged cliffs or by boat. That makes for an even more tranquil setting, especially this time of year. You'll find many charming Greek villages throughout the area to take advantage of warm hospitality and









in the mid-Atlantic, April is a wonderful time to come, with the flowers starting to bloom



brighter, the sun shining stronger, and the days getting longer. It's also a peak month for whale


watching, with many different whales passing through during their migration, including blue

Marrakech, Morocco BEST PLACES TO STAY → Nestled at the foot of the Atlas mountains, the city of Marrakech enjoys pleasant weather in April with daytime highs in the mid-70s, perfect for sightseeing and exploring the bazaars. Plus, the hillsides will be bursting with almond blossoms. Beautiful if chaotic, it's an exciting mix of old and new where you'll see fortune tellers, snake charmers, and centuries-old markets that are full of color, including barrels of spices like turmeric, saffron, ginger, and cinnamon that are tucked among the tapestries and hookahs. Charleston, South Carolina Charleston, South Carolina BEST PLACES TO STAY → Charleston can be brutally hot with high humidity during the summer, but in April, temperatures are perfectly warm while the magnolia trees will be in bloom, creating a gorgeous display. The city celebrates its horticulture with the month-long Spring Festival of Houses and Gardens, and you'll be able to walk through the private gardens of some of the most magnificent historic homes, many highlighted by brightly colored azaleas. The city also has a beautiful waterfront,
