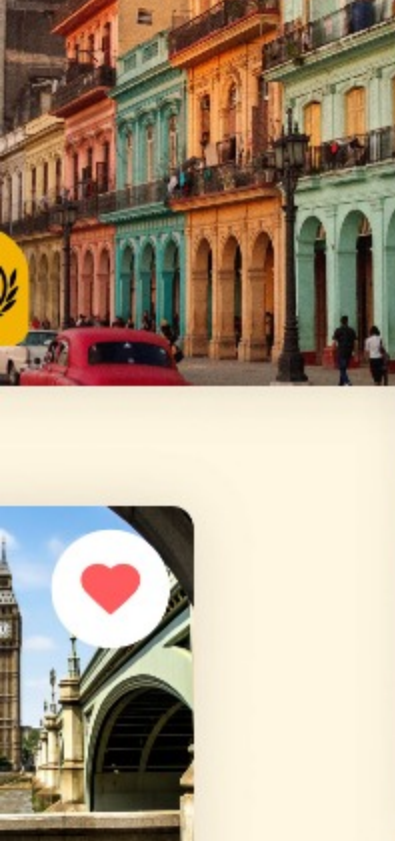
03. Maui

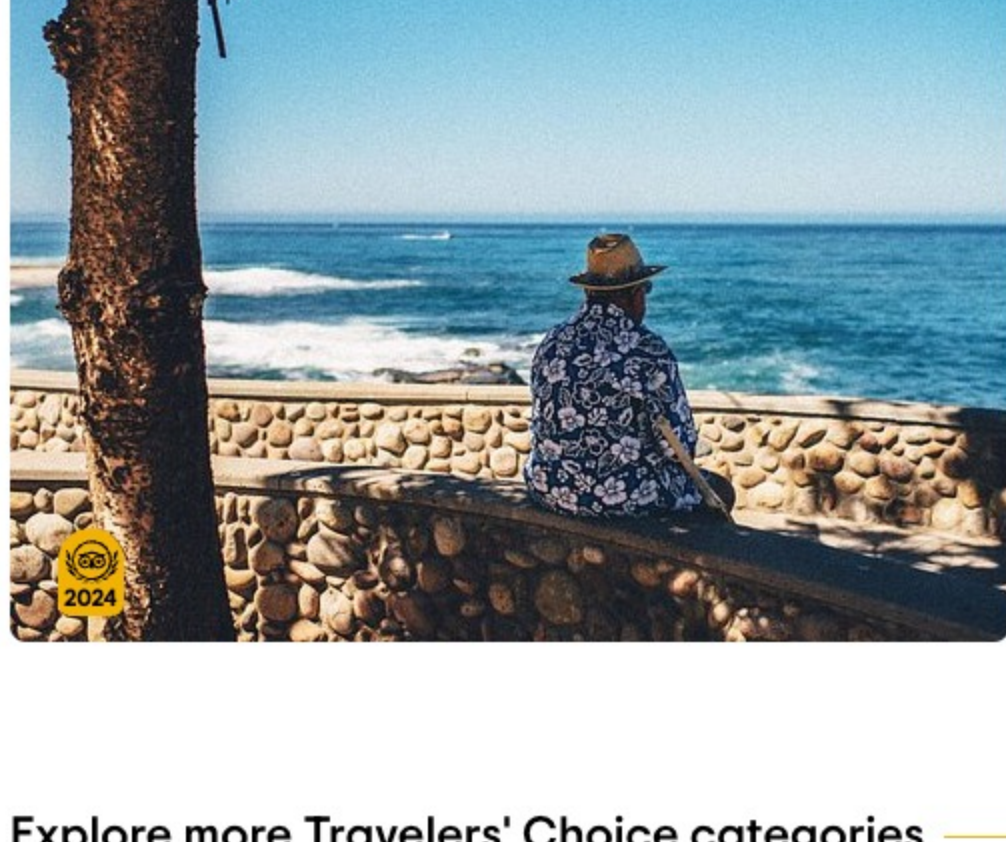
