

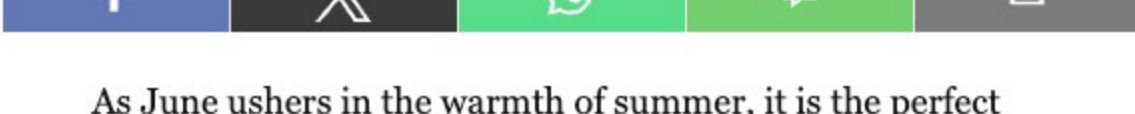

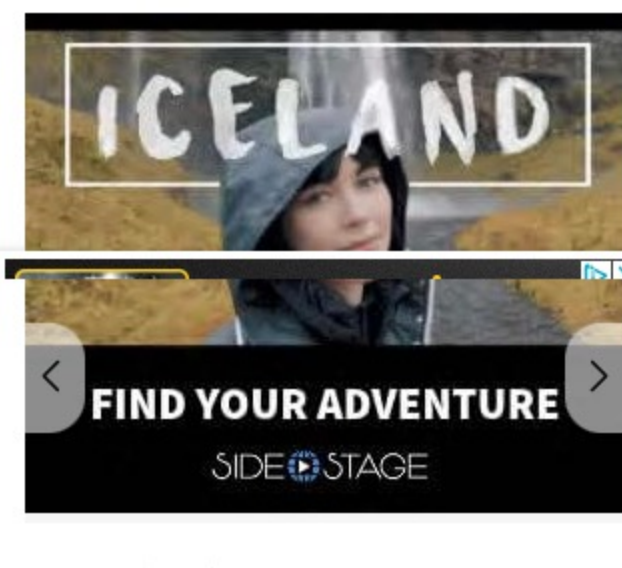


4. San Francisco, California

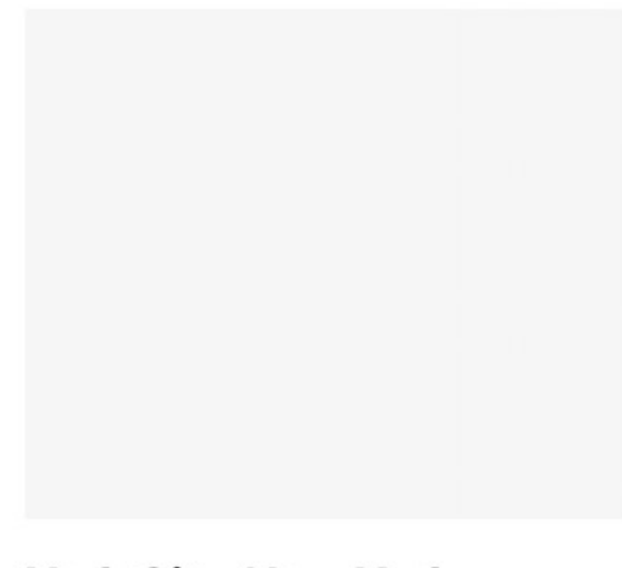
8. Seattle, Washington
